INSTRUCTIONS

The Student Application for Admission ("Application") should be completed by the student's parent/guardian. Please print all answers legibly. If a field does not apply, please write "N/A." Failure to provide information on this Application sufficient to permit the school to offer admission to the student based on qualifying residency will require a conference with a school representative to obtain additional information.

ADMISSION PROCESS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Apply: A student applying for admission to Lincoln Preparatory School (the "School") for the 2017-2018 school year must complete a Student Application for Admission ("Application"). Applications for the 2017-2018 school year are accepted 9:00 a.m., Monday, May 2, 2017, through 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 31, 2017 ("Open-Enrollment Period"). Students can apply using one of three methods:

Provisional Admission: All students who reside within Louisiana who have submitted an Application during the Open-Enrollment Period ("Eligible Applicants") will be notified of provisional admission pending the close of the Open-Enrollment Period and the determination of the need for a lottery.

Lottery: If the number of Eligible Applicants does not exceed the number of vacancies, then all Eligible Applicants who have timely applied during the Open-Enrollment Period will be offered admission. If there are more Eligible Applicants than available spaces in a grade, then a lottery will be conducted at The Lincoln Preparatory School cafeteria, at 6:00 pm Monday, June 5, 2017. Students not offered a seat following the lottery will placed on a waiting list based on their lottery position.

Notification of admission will be made by telephone, e-mail, or U.S. Postal Service. FAILURE OF A PARENT/GUARDIAN TO RESPOND WITHIN FIVE (5) CALENDAR DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE TELEPHONE CALL OR E-MAIL, OR WITHIN FIVE (5) CALENDAR DAYS OF A POST-MARKED LETTER, WILL FORFEIT HIS OR HER POSITION IN THE LOTTERY. PARENTS/GUARDIANS SHOULD CALL THE SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY UPON RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE IN ORDER TO PRESERVE THEIR STUDENT'S POSITION IN THE LOTTERY.

Exemptions: The following students are exempt from the lottery and shall be automatically offered admission to the School: (1) students enrolled at Lincoln Preparatory School as of May 2, 2017; and (2) siblings of students enrolled at Lincoln Preparatory School as of May 2, 2017.

Waiting List: If a vacancy arises before or during the 2017-2018 school year, the next Eligible Applicant on the waiting list will be offered admission and then removed from the waiting list.

Applications Received After the Open-Enrollment Period: If an Application is received from an Eligible Applicant after the close of the Open-Enrollment Period, the Eligible Applicant's name will be added to the waiting list behind the names of the Eligible Applicants who timely applied.

Enrollment Packet: Students offered admission to the School—as well as the first ten Eligible Applicants on the waiting list—will be required to complete the school's Student Enrollment Packet ("Enrollment Packet"). STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION PACKET (ALONG WITH ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION) WITHIN 30 CALENDAR DAYS OF RECEIVING THE REGISTRATION PACKET WILL BE DEEMED TO HAVE WITHDRAWN FROM THE SCHOOL (OR WITHDRAWN THEIR APPLICATION) TO MAKE ROOM FOR OTHER ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS.

Re-Apply: Students still on the waiting list on May 2, 2018, who wish to apply for admission for the 2018-2019 school year, will need to re-apply during the 2018-2019 Open-Enrollment Period.

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS

Residency Information: Subject to applicable law, the school may accept only those students within the school's designated geographic boundary. As such, students will be required to show proof of residency when completing the Enrollment Packet. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in the immediate initiation of procedures to exclude the student from admission.

Parental Rights: The completion of this Application does not determine the parental relationship and does not affect legal right of access to the student or the student's records.

Non-Discrimination: In accordance with state law and the School's charter; it is the policy of the School to prohibit discrimination in student admission on the basis of race, religion, gender, ethnicity, national origin, intelligence level as ascertained by an intelligence quotient examination, or identification as a child with an exceptionality as defined in R.S. 17:1942(B).
