



Special Education : Child Search

Child Search is a nationwide effort to locate all children with disabilities, ages zero through twenty-one, who are not receiving educational services. Child Search is a part of Special Education in Louisiana schools. It is designed to identify, locate, and evaluate children who may be in need of special education services and are not currently enrolled in school.

WHICH CHILDREN ARE ELIGIBLE?

Children ages 0 through 21, who are not enrolled in an educational program and may have a special need in one or more of the following areas:

- Speech or Language
- Vision or Hearing
- Physical or Orthopedic Adaptation
- Emotional Development
- Social Development
- Learning Development
- Intellectual Development
